

E-POSTER GUIDELINES

1. General information

- All posters accepted for MPIC 2021 will be displayed in digital format only on high-resolution monitors. All Poster presentation will be presented in multi-media E-Posters.

2. Instructions for e-posters preparation

- Poster should be composed using PowerPoint with high resolution.
- Poster will be set in portrait style in one slide **ONLY**.
- Poster should be written **ONLY** in English language.
- To get started with your e-poster creation, click Template button.
- Title of the E-Poster (should be brief and match with the submitted abstract).
- Names and affiliations of all authors (each author to be marked with superscript Arabic number (such as 1, 2) with their corresponding institute affiliation and their addresses.
- The logo of the affiliated institution/university should be placed on the upper left-hand corner, whilst the first author's colour photograph (passport style) should be placed on the upper right-hand corner of the poster.
- Font size: ≥ 16 .
- Posters should include a good combination of words, pictures, and graphics. They should include the results and conclusions of the papers, but authors are suggested to avoid including too much text in it.
- Content of your e-poster presentation should have:
 - Research (Introduction, Objectives, Materials and Methods, Results, Conclusion, References and Acknowledgment).
 - Contact details (optional), so that interested delegate may contact you.
 - Data must be given in units that are generally accepted in scientific publications (international metric system is preferred).

3. Instructions for e-posters presentation

- Duration for e-poster presentation is up to 3 minutes.
- Presenter is required provide an e-poster using high resolution PowerPoint. Along with recorded presentation video.
- Creating good quality audio is all in the details. Please follow the steps below to ensure your audio is clear.
 - i. Find a quiet place where you can control the environment.
 - ii. Mute computers, cell phones, and other items that could interfere with your recording.
 - iii. Be prepared. Have a script or an outline of what you are going to say before recording.
 - iv. Hold or place the device 6-12 inches away from and slightly to the side of your mouth.
 - v. Maintain the same distance from the mic throughout your recording.

4. E-poster video presentation submission

- File format: Required format (mp4 format only).
- Please name the files based on your paper ID (**PaperID.mp4**)

- Failure to submit your e-poster by the deadline would result your presentation being cancelled.

**6 winners will be selected for e-poster presentation and will be shown during the conference event.
